All our products where appropriate carry the CE mark. Some items have age restrictions , they tell you how old children must be to play safely with a particular item.

The ages shown on this website and products are to be used as recommended or suggested guidance only.

Always look for the CE mark. Toys without it may not be intended as a toy but a novelty which may not be suitable for children to play with.

Only buy toys which are suitable for the age of the child.

Although a toy may be certified as suitable for children over the age of 3 it may not be appropriate for a 3 year old or older due to the complexity and / or components of the toy.

Toys that contain small parts are not recommended for children under the age of 3.

Always read, follow and keep any warnings or instructions received with a toy.

Always dispose of any packaging, tags and any removable and / or loose parts before giving to a child especially under 3 years.

Keep very fluffy toys away from young children as this could be a choking hazard.

The fillings found in soft toys including the filling supplied for the bear kits and other soft toys can also choke young children, once made up check openings are secure.

To prevent trips and falls tidy all toys away after use.

Store toys designed for older children separate to toys used by younger children to prevent accidents and avoid choking hazards.

Always supervise your children's play.

Always ensure there is adult supervision when stuffing and making the bear and bear kit(s).
